Symptoms


An ear infection often occurs in conjunction with a variety of symptoms that vary depending on the specific form of ear infection. Symptoms may also vary in character and intensity between individuals.

- Ear pain or tenderness
- Swelling or heat around or behind the ear
- Ear discharge that does not look like earwax

Itching of the ear canal

In some cases, people experience more severe symptoms, which is generally indicative of a more serious problem. These complications include:

- Fever
- Headache with severe stiff neck
- Severe dizziness or vertigo
- Loss of hearing
- Confusion, excessive sleepiness, or irritability
