OPELIKA (AP) — Alabama House Speaker Mike Hubbard helped arrange and attended meetings with state officials as part of his economic development work for a municipal-owned gas utility, southeast Alabama officials testified Friday.

Dothan Mayor Mike Schmitz testified that Hubbard attended meetings Gov. Robert Bentley, Alabama Department of Commerce Secretary Greg Canfield and others about industries were trying to recruit to the area. Republican Rep.
